**LAND GRANTS**

- **Burtchville Township** (St. Clair County)

Purpose: To support the development of a segment of the Bridge-to-Bay Trail that will connect two units of Lakeport State Park, a historic chapel, and township property, and will create non-motorized access to beaches and Lake Huron.
