**LAND GRANTS**

- **Charter Township of Shelby** (*Macomb County*)

**Award:** \$72,500

**Purpose:** To support the creation of a greenway through River Bends Park completing a trail that will link Metropolitan Beach Metropark and Stony Creek Metropark, and will connect with a string of local parks and provide a link to the Clinton River and Macomb Orchard trails.

- **City of Allen Park** (*Wayne County*)

**Award:** \$25,000

**Purpose:** To support the construction of the Allen Park greenway from Champaign to Brody streets, providing much needed access to one of the city's major recreation and educational facilities, and to promote safe travel for the residents of Allen Park and the surrounding Downriver communities.

- **City of Southfield** (*Oakland County*)

**Award:** \$95,000

**Purpose:** To support the purchase of a 16-acre parcel of land along the Rouge River Green Corridor, at the confluence of the Rouge and Franklin Rivers. Acquisition of this property will connect two city parks and will allow the public access to the Rouge and Franklin Rivers, which are the only natural bodies of water in the area.

**Award:** \$34,300

**Purpose:** To support the construction of the Bauer Road Greenway connecting Genoa and Hamburg townships with the city of Brighton and the Brighton State Recreation Area.

## **PREDEVELOPMENT GRANTS**

- **Detroit Economic Growth Association** (*Wayne County*)

**Award:** \$12,000

**Purpose:** To support the final stage planning of the Bates Street Outfall along the Detroit River. The Bates Street Outfall, when completed, will connect the Renaissance Center Promenade with the existing riverwalk, which extends from Hart Plaza past Cobo Hall.

**Award:** \$95,000

**Purpose:** To support the development of construction and engineering plans for the North-South Connector of the Downriver Linked Greenways Initiative, from Gibraltar to Trenton.
